1	2	U Obrtničkoj školi Koprivnica obrazuje se velik broj učenika iz socijalno ugroženih obitelji kojima je potrebna pomoć u redovitom pohađanju nastave i ispunjavanju školskih obveza (besplatni udžbenici, mjesečne prijevozne karte za autobus i vlak, prehrana u školi, sanitarne knjižice, radna odijela, obuća, odjeća i sl.). Među učenicima trogodišnjih smjerova u područjima strojarstva (automehaničar) i ugostiteljstva (konobar i kuhar), od kojih je sedamnaest prijavljeno za mobilnost u Velenje i Postojnu, prepoznati su potencijalni sudionici koji imaju potrebu za financijskom pomoći. Dodatnu pomoć tražimo za dvoje učenika kojima bi se kupila radna oprema za mobilnost te ostalo ovisno o osobnoj potrebi učenika kako bi im se olakšalo sudjelovanje u mobilnosti i izjednačile njihove mogućnosti s onima ostalih učenika. Projekt "EUjedinjeni u Obrtničkoj2020!" omogućit će stručno osposobljavanje za 33 učenika iz područja elektrotehnike,računalstva,strojarstva i ugostiteljstva te usavršavanje 6 nastavnika iz područja informatike/računalstva,strojarstva,elektrotehnike,matematike i fizike. Time ćemo nastaviti ostvarivati ciljeve zadane Strategijom internacionalizacije naše ustanove. Projekt "EUjedinjeni u Obrtničkoj2020!" obuhvaća 6 različitih mobilnosti(3 mobilnosti nastavnika i 3 mobilnosti učenika). Mobilnosti učenika planiramo provesti u studenom 2020.g. kako bismo učenike stigli kvalitetno pripremiti i kako bi ostalo dovoljno vremena za diseminaciju nakon povratka. Iskustvo je pokazalo da je za ovakve mobilnosti učenika najkvalitetnije trajanje od 3 tjedna jer nije predugo, a dovoljno je da učenici usvoje nova znanja. Mobilnosti su usmjerene na znanja i vještine potrebne na tržištu rada koje učenici ne mogu usvojiti tijekom školovanja u matičnoj ustanovi.

Mobilnost učenika u Velenju uključuje mobilnost 16 učenika iz dvaju trećih razreda smjerova tehničar za računalstvo i elektrotehničar, koji će obavljati praksu u Šolskom centru Velenje,te dva nastavnika u pratnji.Partnerstvo s ovom ustanovom već je dugogodišnje i obuhvatit će usavršavanje u području 3D modeliranja,CNC izrade,PLC-a,pametne instalacija unutar pametnih kuća,upotreba KNX elemenata i komunikacijskih standarda,programiranje mobilnih aplikacija i izrada mrežnog dizajna što nije dostupno učenicima u matičnoj ustanovi.

Mobilnost učenika ugostiteljskih smjerova u Velenju uključuje 12 učenika trećih razreda smjera kuhar i konobar u Šolski centar Velenje,te dva nastavnika u pratnji. Učenici će obavljanjem stručne prakse u partnerskoj ustanovi moći raditi s novim i modernijim tehnologijama, uređajima i opremom na kojoj ne mogu raditi u našoj školi. Učenici će usavršiti znanja i vještine u području gastronomije radeći na aparatima suvremene tehnologije:dimilica, aparat sa dušikom, vulkansko kamenje, molekularna kuhinja, suvremena miksologija, dekoriranje hrane i usvajanje novih trendova u ugostiteljstvu. Mobilnost učenika u Postojnu uključuje mobilnost 5 učenika drugog i trećeg razreda zanimanja automehaničar u partnerskoj ustanovi Šolski centar Postojna i jednog nastavnika u pratnji. Učenici će upoznati nove sustave za auto dijagnostiku, vrste pogonskih agregata koji koriste obnovljive izvore energije. Naučit će kako te sustave pravilno instalirati, pustiti u pogon te riješiti moguće greške.

Svi učenici su malodobni,većina ih dolazi iz obitelji koje im ne mogu omogućiti odlazak u inozemstvo te im sati pripreme neće biti dovoljni za samostalan odlazak u inozemstvo,s čime se ni neki roditelji ne bi složili.Nastavnici u pratnji bit će veza između matične i partnerske ustanove,učenika i roditelja te brinuti o zdravstvenom stanju učenika, ponašanju, sigurnosti i uključenosti u sve aktivnosti.

Sve mobilnosti nastavnika su orijentirane na područja koja se brzo razvijaju,uključuju "job-shadowing" i planiraju se provesti u prvom polugodištu šk.god. 2020./2021.

Mobilnost u Postojnu uključuje jednog nastavnika iz područja informatike/računalstva tijekom dva tjedna. Nastavnik će pratiti izvođenje nastave u partnerskoj ustanovi Šolski centar Postojna iz područja 3D modeliranja upotrebom CREO alata za crtanje 3D modela i iz područja programiranja u programskom jeziku Python. Mobilnost u Sevilli uključuje jednog nastavnika iz područja strojarstva i jednog nastavnika iz područja elektrotehnike tijekom dva tjedna u ustanovi VET center Salesianos Trinidad,a koje će organizirati partnerska-posrednička ustanova EUROMIND.Nastavnik strojarstva će se upoznati s praktičnim usavršavanjem u radionicama i u učionici,upoznati će nove načine korištenja nastavnih sredstava za bolju provedbu nastavnih sadržaja,učit će o obnovljivim izvorima energije u strojarstvu.Nastavnik elektrotehnike će usporediti rad kolega iz područja

elektronike, upoznati vrstu opreme za izvođenje vježbi i provođenje praktične nastave iz drugog kuta, posebice u područjima: popravak elektroničkih uređaja i pronalazak kvarova, mikroupravljači za IoT.

Mobilnost u Velez Malagu uključuje dva nastavnika iz područja matematike i jednog nastavnika iz područja fizike u novoj partnerskoj ustanovi IES Juan de la Cierva.Nastavnici matematike bi naučili kako koristiti nova nastavna pomagala;poboljšati znanje o nekonvencionalnim metodama podučavanja.Poseban interes jednog nastavnika su trigonometrija i njezine primjene,funkcije i njezine primjene,dok drugog analitička geometrija i njezina primjena.Nastavnik iz područja fizike stekao bi nova znanja korištenja novih nastavnih pomagala,upoznao bi inovativne metode podučavanja.Poseban interes nastavnika iz područja fizike su termodinamika,optika,elektromagnetizam i akustika.

Mobility project "EUnited in Obrtnička2020!" will enable training abroad for 33 students in the areas of electrical engineering, computing, mechanical engineering and hospitality, and staff training for six teachers in the areas of ICT, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, mathematics and physics. The goals defined by the Internationalization Strategy of our institution will thus be further achieved.

The project consists of six mobility activities – 3 learner mobilities and 3 staff mobilities.

Learner mobilities are planned during November 2020, which enables proper preparation and enough time for quality dissemination activities after the return from the mobility. In our experience, the training duration of three weeks is optimal since it is not too long but gives enough time to acquire new skills. All the mobilities include training focused on knowledge and skills necessary on the labour market but unavailable in the home institution.

First learner mobility in VELENJE includes mobility of 16 students in their third year in the occupations technician in electrical engineering or computing technician in the Šolski Center Velenje. They will do their training in the partner institution Šolski center Velenje, where they can learn about 3D modelling, CNC, PLC, mobile applications programming, web design, radio-technics, smart installations.

Second learner mobility in VELENJE includes the training of 12 students in their third year in the occupations waiter and chef in the Šolski Center Velenje. The partner institution is specialized for the mentioned occupations and very well-equipped, so the students will be able to work with new and modern technologies and equipment.

Learner mobility to Postojna includes five students in their second (or third) year in the areas of mechanical engineering – car mechanic in the Solski Center Postojna. The students will learn about new systems for car diagnostics, the types of powertrains that use renewable energy. They will learn how to properly install, start up, and troubleshoot these systems. Each of the learner mobilities includes one/two accompanying teacher during the whole mobility. All students are underage, most of them from families that cannot enable trips abroad. Preparation classes will not be enough to prepare the students for these mobilities without adult escort. Accompanying teachers will be the connection between the students' home and partner institution, parents and students, they will take care of the students' health conditions, their behaviour, safety and participation in all the activities.

The mobility in Postojna includes job shadowing of one teacher in the area of IT for two weeks in the Solski Center Postojna. The teacher will monitor the delivery of 3D modelling lessons using the CREO 3D Model Drawing Tool and the Python programming language. The teacher will apply the advanced programs in the two-year syllabus of Algorithms and Programming and Embedded Computer Systems, and within the Center of Competence of Electrical Engineering and Computing, in the 3D modelling course.

The mobility to the Seville includes a job shadowing of one teacher in the field of mechanical engineering and one teacher in the field of electrical engineering, which will be organized in VET center Salesianos Trinidad by the partner-intermediary institution EUROMIND.

A mechanical engineering teacher will become familiar with practical training in workshops and in the classroom, learn new ways of using teaching aids to better deliver teaching content, and learn about renewable energy in mechanical engineering.

An electrical engineering teacher will compare the work of colleagues in the field of electronics, get to know the type of exercise equipment and practice from a different angle, especially in the areas of: repairing electronic devices, fault finding, microcontrollers for IoT.
